All entries must be made by Saturday 19th August 2023

No late or telephone entries allowed.

Hard hats to the current British Standard MUST be worn at all times whilst mounted on the showground.. ALL stallions and colts, 2 years old and over, must be adequately bitted.

Where the height of a horse or pony is specified in any class, the judge, steward or other official may require such an animal to be measured unless the animal has a current official measurement certificate issued by the Joint Measurement Scheme.

All equines attending the showground must have up to date Equine Influenza vaccinations, the organisers reserve the right to check vaccination passports at any time.

The exercising of horses/ponies will only be allowed in the designated collecting rings. No exercising may occur in the box park.

The parent or guardian must, if required, produce to the Secretary, a certified copy of the entry of birth of any child competing in the children's classes within seven days of the show.

All exhibitors and competitors must be covered by a Public Liability Policy including show use. The Society reserves the right to require any exhibitor to produce proof that a suitable Policy is in force.

The decision of the judges will be regarded as final.

Objections must be lodged with the show secretary in writing up to 15 minutes after the completion of a class and must be accompanied with a deposit of £100 which will be returned if the complaint is upheld. All timings are approximate and subject to change and it is the competitor's responsibility to present themselves in the ring for the start of their class.

The committee reserve the right to amalgamate, divide or cancel any classes and refuse entry to, or remove from any class any person(s);

- (a) that behave in an irresponsible or offensive manner or
- (b) whose horse/pony they consider unfit to compete.

Each competitor will be issued with an entry pass and one other pass into the show. Anyone else accompanying the competitor must purchase an entry ticket in advance. Failure to do so may result in you being refused entry to the lorry park.

ALL competitors take part at their own risk. The organisers do not hold themselves responsible for any accident that might occur to horse, rider, property or spectator.

OFFER OF SILVER-PLATED SPOONS AND ROSETTES AT AFFILIATED SHOWS FOR MARES, FILLIES AND STALLIONS

The Shire Horse Society is pleased to award to any Affiliated Society, a Spoon and Rosette for the Best Mare or Filly and a Spoon and Rosette for the Best Stallion at their Annual Show. Conditions of the Award are as follows:

- 1. A Spoon and a Rosette for the Best Mare or Filly and a Spoon and Rosette for the Best Stallion (providing there is a separate class(es) for Stallions) exhibited in the Shire classes.
- 2. The winner of the Special Prize must be a member of the Shire Horse Society.
- 3. Entries cannot be accepted at Affiliated Shows in classes for Shires or Heavy Horses from any person who has been either suspended or removed from membership of the Shire Horse Society or has been excluded from exhibiting for prizes at Shows, Sales or Exhibitions or from taking part in any Show organised by the Shire Horse Society.
- 4. No animal to be eligible to take more than one Silver Spoon during any one year. The Shire Horse Society Spring Show being excepted.
- 5. THE WINNING ANIMAL MUST BE REGISTERED OR ELIGIBLE FOR REGISTRATION IN THE STUD BOOK OR GRADE B REGISTER.
- 6. The Judge invited to officiate must be on the Society's Official Panel and has the right to withhold the award of the Silver Spoon and Rosette if an exhibit does not show sufficient merit.
- 7. The Council reserves the right in offering Spoons, to award them only to persons approved by the Shire Horse Society

Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However, in order to qualify both owner and rider/exhibitor need to be a current showing member and have a valid qualification card. Members should apply to CHAPS (UK) for the appropriate qualifier card.

The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held in 2024 (date to be confirmed).
