Hope Show will take place on the Bank Holiday **Monday 26<sup>th</sup> August 2024**, and we very much hope that you will be able to join us.

Entry fees for this year remain at £5.00 per car, £3.00 per motorcycle this includes entry to the show for yourself and **one** passenger.

Throughout the day there will be the usual abundance of entertainment to see and do, with trade stands, sheep dog trials, vintage tractors and of course lots going on in the main and supporting rings plus Craft, Horticulture and Food tents.

A Challenge Trophy will be awarded to each of the classes listed below, and further awards will be made to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners in each class, dependant upon the number of entries received. An additional award "The Hartley Trophy" will be awarded at the Judge's discretion.

Class 1. Veteran cars (up to 1918)	Class 5. Classic cars 1501 to 2500cc
Class 2. Vintage cars (1919 – 1930)	Class 6. Classic cars over 2501cc
Class 3. All other cars made before 1945	Class 7. The Hartley Trophy
Class 4. Classic cars up to 1500cc	Class 8. Classic motorcycles

Acceptance of entries in classes 4, 5, 6 will be at the discretion of the organizers, but as a guide to intending entrants, any car to be considered for inclusion in these classes will have to be over 20 years old and in tiptop condition.

I attach an entry form which I hope you will return to me either at the above address or by email as soon as possible, enclosing the relevant entry fee. (Cheques should be made payable to "Hope Show") if you would like to pay online, please email me and I will let you have the bank details. Also attached please see the Hope Show rules and regulations for information. Can I remind everyone that ALL entries must have a valid Road Insurance Policy which we will need to have sight of it is desirable but not a necessity to have public liability insurance.

Exhibitor stickers, entrance passes, numbers, etc will be sent out mid August. Please display clearly as you enter the Show Ground

All vehicles should be in position by 9.30am, and whilst I appreciate that some entrants have a fair distance to travel, and it takes time in the older cars, the show organizers hope that you will try and comply, and that you will stay at least until after the Grand Parade and Prize Presentation.

Further to the request of past years, could you please include your e-mail address on the entry form, as this makes life a whole lot easier. If you haven't or can't – don't worry.
